


Primary Care Allied Health Professions Ambassadors: launch and update

Introduction

Health Education England's <u>North West Allied Health Professions Network</u> are supporting new roles in primary care through coordinated approaches to workforce supply and transformation.

We are delighted therefore to launch the role of our Primary Care Allied Health Professions (AHP) Ambassadors across the North West.

Background: AHPs in Primary Care

The <u>new GP contract</u> ensures general practice plays a leading role in every Primary Care Network (PCN), including teams of health professionals working together in local communities. This introduces new roles in primary care for several allied health professions (AHPs)¹ under the Additional Roles Reimbursement Scheme.

The <u>recent update from NHS England and NHS Improvement and the BMA</u> extends funding for AHPs and the scheme now includes:

- First contact practitioner physiotherapists (from April 2020).
- Occupational therapists, dietitians and podiatrists (from April 2020).
- Advanced Paramedic Practitioners (from April 2021).

Successful implementation of these roles will benefit from coordinated, sustainable approaches to workforce supply, training and education across the region.

Allied Health Professions are: art therapists, dramatherapists, music therapists, chiropodists/podiatrists, dietitians, occupational therapists, operating department practitioners, orthoptists, osteopaths, prosthetists and orthotists, paramedics, physiotherapists, diagnostic radiographers, therapeutic radiographers, speech and language therapists.

AHP Ambassadors' roles

As a team the Primary Care AHP ambassadors will work in partnership to:

- Support understanding and uptake of AHP roles in primary care across Primary Care Networks.
- 2. Provide advice and support on developing new AHP roles in primary care, including training, education, recruitment and retention.
- 3. Develop a collection of primary care AHP case studies from across the region.
- 4. Support the development of a North West AHP primary care collaborative.
- 5. Work with Higher Education Institutes to support the future AHP workforce in primary care.



To do this the ambassadors will work with HEE, primary care networks, training hubs, regional teams and other stakeholders; and connecting with other workforce ambassadors across the region.

They will provide support within their local system as well as more widely across the North West region and nationally.
